everything you need to know about fractures and fracture healing Jan 13 2021 most fractures heal in 6 8 weeks but this varies tremendously from bone to bone and in each person based on many of the factors discussed above hand and wrist fractures often heal in 4 6 weeks whereas a tibia fracture may take 20 weeks or more healing time for fractures are divided into three phases 1
